Downstairs at the Alibi Room has been outfitted with a deep new sound and video projection system, making it Seattle's most intimate plug-and-play multimedia performance space. Wired for DJs, live acts, and projection, the room hosts weekly events and is available for private parties.

NEW EVENTS

Fridays and Saturdays: club nights hosted by a rotating lineup of Seattle luminaries including DJs **SAME DNA, PAUL EDWARDS, HEAVY, EDDIE, SHAPESHIFTER, PAULY D, and HIDEKI.** Party goes 10 pm - 2 am, 21+, never a cover.

Mondays: Bring your Own Projector (BYOP). While there is an emphasis on sharing 8 & 16 mm films on vintage projectors, anyone can come down to watch or share art in other media. DJs can bring laptops or vinyl to spin on the house gear. Musicians can plug into the live board and jam to the visuals. The evening is spontaneous and unstructured—no stage, no spotlight, no lineup. 6 pm - midnight EVERY Monday, 21+, drink specials apply, no cover.

First Thursday Artwalk Afterparty: Late evening artist receptions, special performances, and DJs spinning until 2 am make this the perfect destination for after the galleries close.
